Soon after the start was bumped and a short distance later was then han when tightened for room. Making the first turn galloped on the heels of ar greyhound, ran wide and lost ground. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance, trainer Mr. S Sultana stated that the greyhour which was up in grade tonight, performs most competitively when able to which it has been doing at its most recent starts. He added that the greyhound began only fairly and consequently was unable to lead. He further added in his opinion, the greyhound has come to the end of its preparation and now be spelled. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparentinjury.

4 Superstar Ethics	Began very awkwardly and lost considerable ground.		
5 Carter O'Brien	Midway between the turn leaving the back straight and the home turn was contacted on the hindquarters, became very unbalanced and lost ground. Midway down the home straight on the second occasion was marred by another greyhound, becoming unbalanced and losing further ground.		
7 One Hot Bandit	A post-race urine sample was obtained.		
8 War Hawk	Stewards interviewed trainer Ms. P Hutchinson's representative in relation to the greyhound's actions midway between the turn leaving the back straight and home turn and again in the home straight on the second occasion whereby it turned its head inwards and made head and muzzle contact with Carter O'Brien. After reviewing all available video footage, considering submissions and the findings of the post-race veterinary examination, Stewards issued an endorsement for Marring under GAR123, with this being its first offence having regard to the provision of GAR128, whereby it has competed in more than 10 events since its last marring offence. The greyhound is now suspended from racing for a period of 28 days and until the completion of a satisfactory Steward's trial under GAR132. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent injury.
